3. Support for Employment and Adaptation at Japanese Companies



Course required

JLPT N3 level or higher

Japanese Language

Kyutech offers **Japanese language classes** and **Business Japanese classes**. There are two courses: one designed for students aiming for **JLPT N2 level**, and another for those aiming for **N1 level**.

Internships

Participation in a **two-week internship** at a Japanese company is mandatory. Kyutech provides pre-internship guidance, matching support, and holds a debriefing post-session.

Career Education

Kyutech develops the skills needed in the workplace through lectures, seminars, and workshops.

Monthly Gathering

Kyutech holds a **monthly gathering** for EDGE students. EDGE students share updates on their Japanese language studies and job search progress, and Kyutech connects you with experts as needed.

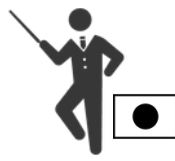
