Extracurricular activities after a state of pre-emergency status

The declaration of a state of pre-emergency issued for Fukuoka prefecture will be lifted after 7 March. However, it is confirmed 143 COVID-19 cases in Kyutech (Jan – Feb 2022). Kyutech issues a notice about extracurricular activity as follow. The policy is subject to change depending on the COVID-19 situations, so please check latest information.

And, Kyutech requests all the students to exercise thorough primary measures to prevent infection and to be more cautions and responsible for your actions.

1. Risk level for extracurricular activity

Extracurricular activities can be allowed under the "Risk Level 3: Strict Caution" in the restart plan of extracurricular activity from 7 March.

2. Training camps, away games/matches, concerts and other events

As exceptions for grade examinations, games and matches for promotion to higher league, and contents to present achievements of long-term activities and so on, such events can be approved by permission, provided that precautions manual is prepared by organizer and the participants are tested negative for PCR testing.

For the permission, clubs and teams need to submit an activity plan to Student Section of each campus. Each plan will undergo a careful checking by the university doctor and Student Section, then Dean's permission will be issued.

3. Precautions during activities

Please take primary measures to prevent infection (wearing a mask, avoid 3Cs, sterilizing hands and fingers) and to be more cautions and responsible for your actions.

4. Prohibitions of events with unavoidable close contacts

In Kyutech, we are seeing more and more infection cases including a cluster due to drinking in group including public drinking, group dining, parties indoor and outdoor, and karaoke party. Please consider about the risk to hold farewell or welcome party and be responsible for your actions.
