

# Application for the Kyutech Fund Scholarship 2021

The Kyutech Fund grants scholarships to self-supporting international students. Please check the overview of the application guidelines below, and submit the necessary documents to the student affairs office of your faculty.

## 1. Eligibility

- Students who have enrolled in a doctorate program from April 2019 onwards
  - \* For those enrollee in April 2020 onwards or those who temporarily returned to own country, and are unable to entry/re-entry Japan due to Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) by deadline, will not be eligible to apply.
- Students of exceptional character and academic capabilities, who are in good health
- Students who are self-supporting and will be able to concentrate on their studies by getting financial support

## 2. Number of positions

Around 20 students

## 3. Support Period

April 2021 – March 2022

- Students starting classes in October 2021 will be only given six months.
- If students were late to entry/re-entry Japan due to Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), scholarship would be granted from the month of arrival.

## 4. Scholarship Amount

30,000yen per month

- Students in a high level of poverty but with strong academic records will receive 48,000 yen.
- However, in the case that students are receiving another scholarship, they will be paid the difference up to the above amounts.

## 5. Documents to submit

- Application Form (Form 1)
- Application form for Screening in Kyutech
- Academic transcript on Live Campus issued by Student Section
- Copies of the Transfer Request Form and your Bank Book (This can be submitted after passing the screening)
- If students were late to entry/re-entry Japan, please submit the copy of document showing the arrival date (page with landing stamp in the passport).
  - \* Registered bank account in Kyutech will be used if any.
  - \* Students may be asked to submit additional documents if needed.

- 6. Restrictions** Only for individuals not already receiving 48,000 yen or more in other scholarships.
