

# Application for Rotary Yoneyama Memorial Scholarship 2022

This scholarship is provided for privately financed international student who is regular undergraduate or graduate student. Please contact the Student Section of your faculty if you want to apply. Read the following guidelines thoroughly to prepare all documents required.

1. Eligible student (as of April, 2022)

Undergraduate	3rd year, 4th year
Master's program	1st year, 2nd year
Doctoral program	2nd year, 3rd year

  - a) other than excellent academic performance, who has an attitude and interest in intercultural understanding and communication skills, also who is physically and mentally healthy to endure study abroad life
  - b) who was born after April 1, 1977 (under 45 years old as of April 1st)
  - c) who will not have any plan to receive scholarships next year
  - d) who has never received Rotary Yoneyama Memorial Scholarship
  - e) who can take the exam (written and Japanese interview) during the period from early December 2021 to the end of January 2022
  - f) who can fulfill the obligations of the Rotary Yoneyama Memorial Scholarship
    - i) to attend regular meetings more than once a month
    - ii) to submit report twice a year
    - iii) to give speeches and to participate district events such as fellowship events, volunteer activities, etc.
2. Amount

Undergraduate student	100,000 yen / month
Graduate student	140,000 yen / month
3. Period  
Up to 2 years. The period will be shorter if you enroll in October.
4. Number of recommendation  
7 students (approximately 600 students through Japan)
5. Documents to be submitted
  - a) Application form (Rotary Yoneyama Memorial Scholarship 2022)
  - b) Photograph data
    - i) electronic data in jpeg, png or gif format within 1MB to be submitted
    - ii) 4cm×3cm, taken within the past 3 months, upper body, full-faced※Data received at photo shop or image data created by using ID photo making app for smartphone
  - c) Resume
  - d) Recommendation letter from assigned professor
    - i) if written by using MS Word, write the same contents as the official one in ONE A4 paper
    - ii) Japanese translation has to be attached if the written language is not Japanese
    - iii) a name stamp must be put, signature will be allowed only for non-Japanese※Financial hardship is not considered as selection criteria, write the recommendations other than financial aspect
  - e) Research plan
    - i) in line with a given topic, write in person by applicant, write in Japanese, horizontal writing, less than 800 words
    - ii) use black ink or black ballpoint pen, must use the official paper to submit
  - f) Essay
    - i) in line with a given topic, write in person by applicant, write in Japanese, horizontal writing, less than 800 words
    - ii) use black ink or black ballpoint pen, must use the official paper to submit
  - g) Academic Transcript  
grades received last year at Japan or the latest one that can be submitted
  - h) Copy of residence card
    - i) PDF data of both sides, clearly visible
    - ii) the date of expiration should be after October 1, 2021
  - i) Copy of letter of admission or certificate of transfer admission  
(only for those enroll or transfer admission in April 2022)
  - j) Application form ver.3 Japanese version (Kyutech selection use)
