After 15 May: Kyutech's policy on classes and activities on/off campus

The Government's declaration of a state of emergency has been lifted on 5 May, but universities are required to take thorough preventive measures for bringing back to normal. In order to take social responsibility and avoid spread of the infection, Kyutech will take cautious response as follows from 15 May to 29 June (throughout the 1st quarter). Please be noted that the policy could be changed depending on the situation.

Item	From 15 May to 29 June
Classes	Provided only in remote class (No face-to-face class in lecture room)
Entering campus (Students)	Prohibited, but the students under following cases are allowed to enter 1) The students who don't have internet access other than the on-campus network to take remote classes 2) The students who need to enter campus for activities related to job search 3) The students who acquired the permission from Dean through their supervisor for research activities etc. 4) The students with entry permission for borrowing books or for other procedures at the University Library *When students conduct research activities etc., they should be watched by faculty staff or other measures need to be taken to prevent accidents. *The students entering campus are required to check body temperature and to avoid airtightened room, crowdedness, and close contact. How to apply for the permission will be informed on each campus. *The residents of on-campus dormitory are allowed to enter
Events and gatherings hosted by the University	Requested to cancel or postpone in principle

Item	From 15 May to 29 June
Extracurricular activities	Cancelled
Training camps, away games/matches (including on-campus games/matches with invited opponents from outside the University), concerts, live shows, events	Cancelled
Choyo Sansou (off-campus training facility)	Closed
Application for the use of Kyutech facilities	Suspended
Events with unavoidable close contacts such as buffet-style party	Requested to cancel or postpone in principle
University library (Tobata and Iizuka)	Opened only on weekdays, from 9:30 to 17:00 -Seats and desks are not available -Visitor's use is suspended -Reservation required to borrow books
